

Prevent spills and keep the roads safe this grape harvest



OVERLOADING COMPROMISES ROAD SAFETY

Spills on the road are slippery and a danger to other road users.

ROAD DAMAGE

Over-mass vehicles can cause damage to the road surface, which is often expensive to fix.

Any vehicle detected over the 'Legal Mass' will have the breach recorded on weighbridge dockets and penalties may apply in line with the seriousness of the breach.
