Lake Wyangan, Nericon and Tharbogang Sewerage Scheme

Lake Wyangan, Nericon and Tharbogang Sewerage Scheme works are about to begin.

Griffith City Council received \$2.1 million in funding from the NSW Government's Restart NSW Water Security for Regions program for Council's installation of sewerage infrastructure for the villages of Lake Wyangan, Nericon and Tharbogang.

Griffith City Council has now completed the planning and tendering phase of the pressure sewer project with installation works scheduled to commence shortly within the three villages.

Hills to Harbor Plumbing has been awarded the contract for the installation and commissioning works for the whole of the scheme, including individual property drainage connections.

The project has been gaining momentum with the award of the Equipment Supply and Scheme Design awarded to Enviro One Services and Installations Pty Ltd of Cleveland Queensland in mid-2017.

As part of the design phase, all properties within the scheme were audited in conjunction with the landowner, and a drainage plan was developed for each property.

Tendering for the installation works was completed in November 2017 and a contract was awarded to the successful tenderer, who has extensive experience in the specialised field of pressure sewer construction.

The project construction period will extend to July 2018 and possibly beyond, depending on weather and other construction variables.


One of the key performance areas of the contract is the requirement to carry out the works within the three villages with minimal impact on the local community. Installation of pressure pipelines will be largely undertaken by directional boring, with access excavations only required for connections and installation of valves and/or flush points.

The first pipelines to be installed will be the reticulation comprising the street mains to the property boundary valve and transfer mains. Works within the properties are expected to commence in late March or April 2018 and all property owners and occupiers will be notified well in advance as part of the contractor's community liaison obligations.



The project depot will be located on the corner of Boorga and Smeeth Roads at Lake Wyangan, and customers are welcome to discuss aspects of the project once works commence and there is a Council presence at the depot.
